

Truth about lies

Most people buy clubs "off the rack", throw them in the bag, and never give a second thought to getting the lie angle checked. In fact, most people are unaware of the significance of the lie angle to their game - but that is not their fault, it is not something that the golf club manufacturers advertise.

Also, if you are a "range rat" then the combination of hard mats and heavy practice sessions can alter the lie of your clubs. This is especially true of softer, forged clubs. If you spend a lot of time at the range or play 3 times a week, then checking your clubs specs should be done at least twice a year.

To give you a better understanding, look below to what a few degrees off does to your accuracy.

- 1* off = leads to 4 yards off line
- 2* off = leads to 8 yards off line
- 3* off = leads to 12 yards off line
